The Shigaraki tanuki (raccoon dog) is also famous, and you can encounter Shigaraki Tanuki figurines located everywhere all around the town. One of the best photo spots is in front of the giant tanuki, at Shigaraki Station, it's the perfect spot for Instagram-worthy photos.

Asamiya Tea




